## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

---

- New Birth Member who lives in the metropolitan Atlanta area
- High School Senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Completion of Application
- Copy of High School Transcript
- 2 Letters of Recommendation - from a high school administrator, teacher or counselor, church leader, or community organization leader where the student serves. At least one of the recommendation letters must be provided by personnel from the applicant's high school.
- Copy of Acceptance Letter(s) from accredited 2- or 4-year colleges or universities
- Completion of Essay (topic and instructions below)

## ESSAY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Write a one-page essay on the following topic: "My Legacy". Based on your relationship with Christ and your personal creed, explain how you are intentionally making a difference in society by consciously working to build a legacy that impacts your family, peers, local society and the global community. The essay must be presented as a double-spaced Word document or pdf document with Times New Roman font size 12 and 1-inch margins.
